Melbourne hearing on rate capping

Four city councils will present their views to the Victorian Parliament's Environment and Planning Committee at a public hearing in Melbourne on Tuesday 3 May for the inquiry into the Victorian Government's rate capping policy.

The public hearing will commence at 12 noon in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House and will involve the following city councils: Yarra; Port Phillip; Hobsons Bay; and Bayside.

The inquiry is examining the outcome of the Victorian Government's rate capping policy on councils' viability, service impacts on local communities and impacts on the provision of local infrastructure.
