Mildura hearing on whether career advice hits the mark

Mildura students, business owners and career advisers will present their views at a public hearing on Thursday 22 March for the parliamentary inquiry into career advice activities in Victorian schools.

As part of its inquiry, the Economic, Education, Jobs and Skills Committee is investigating the career advice needs of young people in regional Victoria and ways to address those needs.

Representatives from the Northern Mallee Local Learning and Employment Network, Sunraysia Institute of TAFE and local secondary schools will also give evidence to the Committee.
