Hearings to examine if career advice is on target

Career service providers, academics and school principals will provide evidence at the first public hearing for the inquiry into career advice activities in Victorian schools on Monday 19 February.

The public hearing will be held from 10:25 am to 4:15 pm at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne.

Representatives from Mitchell Institute, state and national career development associations and Victorian Local Learning and Employment Networks will also present their views to the Economic, Education, Jobs and Skills Committee.

The Committee is examining how well career advice is meeting the needs of Victorian students and the challenges faced by school career advisers. It will also investigate strategies to improve career advice and focus on the services available for young people in regional Victoria.
