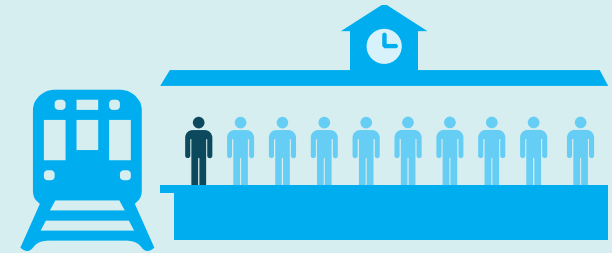
Key facts – public transport



Over 300,000 people are using the public transport network every day



About two thirds of travellers are commuting to and from their place of work or study



About one third of travellers are picking up groceries or other items

Key facts – roads and road safety



40 per cent reduction in traffic volumes during early Stage 3 – now 30 per cent



13 per cent reduction in the number of commercial vehicles using the road network



Most drive tests and all computer-based licence testing suspended

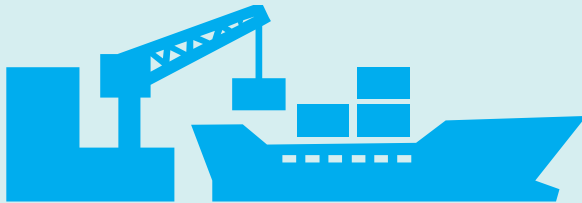

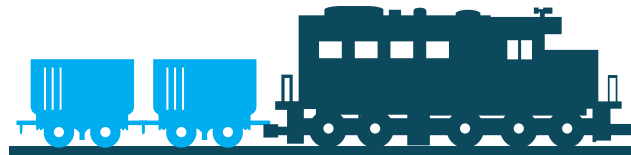

Container throughput at the Port of Melbourne down 10 per cent

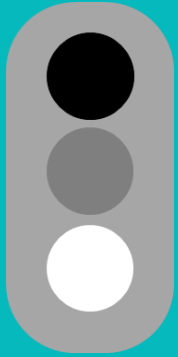


Interstate and intrastate rail freight volumes holding up.



Truck curfews temporarily suspended to enable goods to be delivered more efficiently

Key facts – walking and cycling



Pedestrian crossing activations down 24 per cent



After falling 80 per cent, CBD pedestrian volumes are steadily increasing



Cycling to the CBD down 80 per cent; cycling for recreation up by 200 to 300 per cent
