



About Goulburn-Murray Water

GOULBURN-MURRAY WATER

- Formally: Goulburn-Murray Rural Water Corporation
 - Trades as Goulburn-Murray Water (GMW)
- Statutory corporation under the Water Act 1989
 - 70% of Victoria's stored water resources
 - 50% of Victoria's groundwater resources
 - Australia's largest irrigation delivery network
 - Source bulk entitlements for northern Victorian systems
 - Delegated resource manager and storage manager








Catchment Management Authorities as local agents
