Metropolitan road initiatives

2021-22 Victorian Budget

- \$51.4 million road and intersection upgrades
- \$12.3 million bridge upgrades
- \$21 million active transport projects

Initiatives in delivery

- \$33.166 billion in major road projects
- \$340 million Keeping Victorians Moving
- \$117 million Metro Road upgrades
- \$15.7 million Pop-up Bike Lanes



Regional road initiatives

2021-22 Victorian Budget

- \$27.7 million road and intersection upgrades
- \$20.1 million bridge upgrades
- \$15.9 million Murray River bridge crossings

Initiatives in delivery

- \$1.73 billion in major road projects
- \$272.4 million Great Ocean Road renewal
- \$60 million Keeping Ballarat Moving
- 1800 km roads resurfaced/rebuilt in 20/21



Victorian Road Safety Action Plan



Reducing transport emissions

- 50 per cent of all new light vehicle sales by 2030 to be zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs)
- \$46 million for ZEV subsidies
- \$10 million to transition Government fleet
- \$19 million to establish a fast-charging network
- \$5 million for commercial sector



Making road freight more efficient

- \$42 million for a safer and more productive road network for freight
- Boosting accessibility for high-productivity freight vehicles to 700km of the road network
- Funding to commence work on automated permit and bridge-assessment system
- Upgrades to bridges at key locations
