Victoria's Creative Industries

- Over **\$22b** economic contribution
- **242,000** jobs (up 20,000 from 2013)
- **\$1.96 billion** in international cultural tourism (up 88% since 2013)
- **65% increase** in international cultural visitors since 2013
- **11.7 million** visits to state-owned cultural institutions – record high



2017-18 Highlights

- Creative State – 40 actions delivered or well underway
- Ground-breaking new programs – Creators Fund, Creative State Commissions
- Regional Centre for Culture
- Blockbuster exhibitions – Van Gogh, NGV Triennial, Dior, Wonderland
- Work kicked off on State Library Victoria and GPAC redevelopments
- New exhibitions at Scienceworks to inspire next generation in STEM
- 8,400 Victorians employed in Victorian screen productions - highlights include 'Ride Like a Girl'

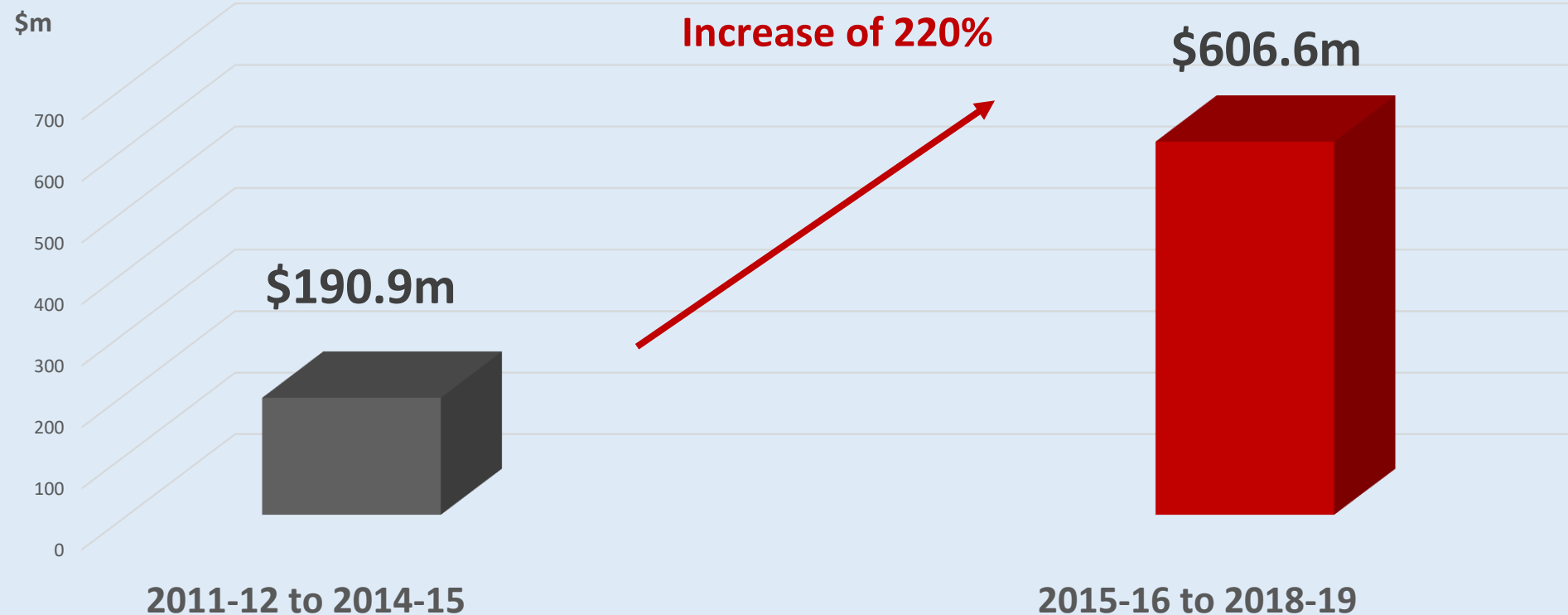
