



## Preparing your expression of interest

Applications for the Victorian Parliament's work experience program are made by expression of interest using the online form. The questions that will be asked on this form are provided here to help you prepare your application:

- Why are you applying for a work experience placement at the Parliament of Victoria?
- Tell us why you have chosen your area of interest?
- What do you hope to achieve from undertaking a work experience placement at the Parliament of Victoria?
- What elective subjects are you currently studying, or would you like to undertake over the next 12 months?
- Tell us about the type of career you might like to pursue?

You'll also be asked to specify your preferred placement dates and area of interest, which includes:

- **Parliamentary Sitting program**  
*Available on the weeks when Parliament is sitting (meetings)*
- **Parliamentary Services Program**  
(Nominate a first and second preference)
  - Business management
  - Facilities Management and Maintenance
  - Community Engagement and Broadcasting
  - Hospitality (Kitchen)
