# **Public hearing on combating public sector corruption and misconduct**

Parliament's Integrity and Oversight Committee is to hold a public hearing on Monday, 21 June 2021.

The hearing, which will be conducted by video-conference, will consider how Victoria's integrity agencies undertake their education and prevention functions to expose and address public sector corruption and misconduct.

On Monday the Committee will hear from Dr Eva Tsahuridu, who has research expertise in business and professional ethics and whistleblowing.

The hearing will be broadcast live from 1:45 pm to 2:10 pm on the Victorian Parliament's [website](#). The schedule is available on the Committee's [website](#).

"This is the third and final public hearing for our inquiry. It builds on highly useful evidence presented to the Committee in public hearings held in late May and early June, as well as detailed submissions we received last year," Committee Chair Jill Hennessy said.

"The public hearings are an important opportunity to hear from a wide range of groups and integrity agencies on the best ways to combat corruption and misconduct in the public sector."
