

## Increase speed limit whilst overtaking

Hi,

I would like to suggest/support the idea that the speed limit can be exceeded whilst performing an overtake. This would mean that a vehicle overtaking a slower moving vehicle would be on the wrong side of the road by a considerable amount if this was allowed. Trying to pass a vehicle doing 90 in a 100 zone would mean I would be on the opposite side of the road for approximately 60 seconds (giving enough space to safely pull back in). This is a ridiculous amount of time to be facing oncoming traffic.

In the pure interests of reducing road toll, this needs to be made law before more motorists are faced with a head on collision due to the fact they are required to stay within the limit when overtaking.

Surely the safest way is get past as quickly as possible and then revert back to the speed limit, as I could then pass them with only being on the opposite side for only a matter of 10-20 seconds rather than 60.
