Submission:

It has been an ongoing concern for many years that many young people attending Daylesford Secondary College and living in Creswick (Creswick does not have a secondary school), are dropped on the side of the Midland Highway in all types of weather, some kilometres out of town. There is no path for them to walk the substantial distance into town and attempting to do so would see them walking on the side of a dual lane highway with vehicles and trucks travelling 100km p/h. The roadside borders areas of scrub and forest is not safe for pedestrians and puts our young people at substantial risk. The only option is to pick the young people up by vehicle however this is not practical for parents who are at work or do not have a car.
