From Bob Redden, I grew up on a farm ~ 10Km out of town, and went by school bus daily to school. In emergencies adults also came on the bus, usually singly. It was slower than going direct by car due to all the stops for children's pick-ups.

I support the option of school buses being an emergency community back-up for rural transport into town, such as a vehicle breakdown, and the need to keep an appointment, or catch a train. There are seating limits on school buses, therefore regular adult commuting is to be discouraged. Any insurance issue should be manageable. The school bus must be seen to be part of the community.
