My daughter finishes school at 3.20, but has to wait 45 minutes after school before they have a bus ready to take the children home on the Meridith 2 bus, which leaves at 4.05

This can be a big problem in winter as they are left out in the elements and does not leave a lot of time when they get home to do chores and home work

The other issue I have is that the children are left unsupervised for 45 minutes with no one to monitor them.

I can only hope no predator decides to groom them, as there is no one there to keep an eye out for them.

I know the school does risk assessments for every excursion and every event they have, but I don't believe anyone has done one for children left for 45 minutes to their own devices in front of the school.

I could see a large law suit in the future, if something ever happened to one of the children.
