Bright in regional Victoria to host hearing on impact of COVID-19 on tourism in the North East

The Legislative Council's Economy and Infrastructure Committee will hear from tourism related business and organisations in Bright next week.

The Committee is examining the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on Victoria's tourism and events sectors. The public hearing will be held at the Bright Community Centre on Wednesday 28 April from 10:00 am to 1:30 pm.

Among the witnesses are the CEOs of the Mount Hotham and Fall's Creek Alpine Resorts, and representatives from Alpine Shire Council and Tourism North East. Bright Brewery and Dal Zotto Wines will also give evidence on the impact of the pandemic on their businesses.
