# **Government officials at use of cannabis inquiry**

High-ranking government authorities will this week appear at a parliamentary inquiry into the use of cannabis in Victoria.

The Legislative Council Legal and Social Issues Committee will hold a public hearing tomorrow (Tuesday, 1 June) commencing at 9 am via Zoom.

Representatives from the Department of Health, Department of Education and Training and Department of Justice and Community Safety will provide information on whole-of-government policy relating to the use of cannabis in Victoria.

“This is a really important opportunity for our Committee and the community to hear first-hand from the people who determine, implement and manage cannabis-related policy in this state,” Committee Chair Fiona Patten said.

“They will also have the chance to respond to the issues raised by other key stakeholders who have already given significant evidence to this inquiry.”
