I am a member of Legalise Cannabis Queensland, I suffer chronic pain, as does my mother, father and grandmother. I have seen my aunties go through chemo, friends too, and it terrifies me that none of them were offered the alternative treatments such as those Peter Mac provide, it was straight into chemical treatment. My mother in law lost her husband recently, and was offered, I quote, "whatever you need, I'll provide a script, just let me know, it helps sometimes just to get the sleep and get through the day." My cousin lost her partner 6 years ago, and also was told something similar - It's not a new thing for doctors to write scripts for "whatever you need," but as soon as you ask about cannabis the tone changes to disgusting and all cards are off the table, I have been told I'm a "junkie" when asking for CBD from Pain Clinic specailists, terrified out of my mind I have not bothered asking questions since, even from doctors that claim to be supportive and trained in Cannabis medicine.

I truly believe we need to regulate this untapped resource, for the environmental, social, industrial, economic and frankly human rights issues it's illegal status brings.

Thank you for this enquiry, I pray the decision is positive for Victoria and the rest of our states to follow, and not in ACT's lead but a much more appropriately regulated, federally passed fashion.
