I will keep this short.

If you as a committee want to make it easier for learners with disability access TAFE you need to start with primary school students.

There is a lack of facilities and learning programs for children with educational and learning disabilities.

A survey was published in 2018 detailing the critical gap in Australian Schools for children with ADHD.

If you look at the survey and apply the same criteria to children in Victoria with educational and learning disabilities then the same critical gap is there.

You need to fix the access for learners with disabilities at the start of their education and not wait until its too late.

It may not be specifically related to your current Inquiry but if you as committee do not consider it now, well in 20 years time there will be another committee going over the same issue.
