Thank you for requesting my 'views, insights and experiences' in relation to the 2014 election.

I ran as an Independent. I previously ran as an independent for council City of Moreland & I put up a team of real Independents in each Ward, & I achieved my objective & was responsible for ending the all time absolute Labor majority. Melbourne's North is treated as a wasteland.

For the 2014 Victorian State Election – District of Pascoe Vale, I found;

- 1. The expense of the campaign letter drops, advertising & resourcing were high but not unexpected.
