Hearings continue conduct of 2018 state election

On Monday 25 November 2019, the Electoral Matters Committee will hold a further public hearing on its inquiry into the conduct of the 2018 Victorian state election.

The public hearing will be from 11:20 am to 12:30 pm at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne.

The Committee will hear from the State Director of the Transport Matters Party as well as an independent candidate at the 2018 state election.

The inquiry is examining how the 2018 Victorian state election was conducted and suggestions on how things could be improved. Issues being considered include enrolling, being a candidate and voting.
