ABORIGINAL AFFAIRS PORTFOLIO

1. How many indigenous people are currently employed in the public service?

(Page 5 of the Aboriginal Affairs portfolio transcript)

Through the Council of Australian Governments National Partnership on Indigenous Economic Participation, Victoria has committed to a target of 1% of its public sector workforce being Indigenous by 2015. The baseline data used to calculate this target was from the 2008 People Matter Survey¹ which found that 1,200 employees in the public sector identified as Indigenous.
