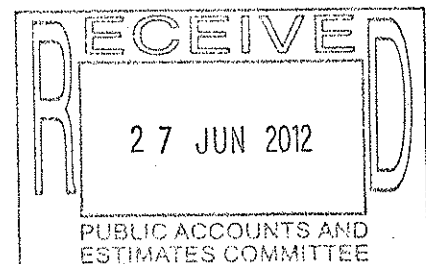

**Response:**

The Victorian Government provides funding for projects which commemorate veterans' service and sacrifice. Up to \$30,000 is available through the Victorian Veterans Fund to a range of eligible organisations for approved projects.
