

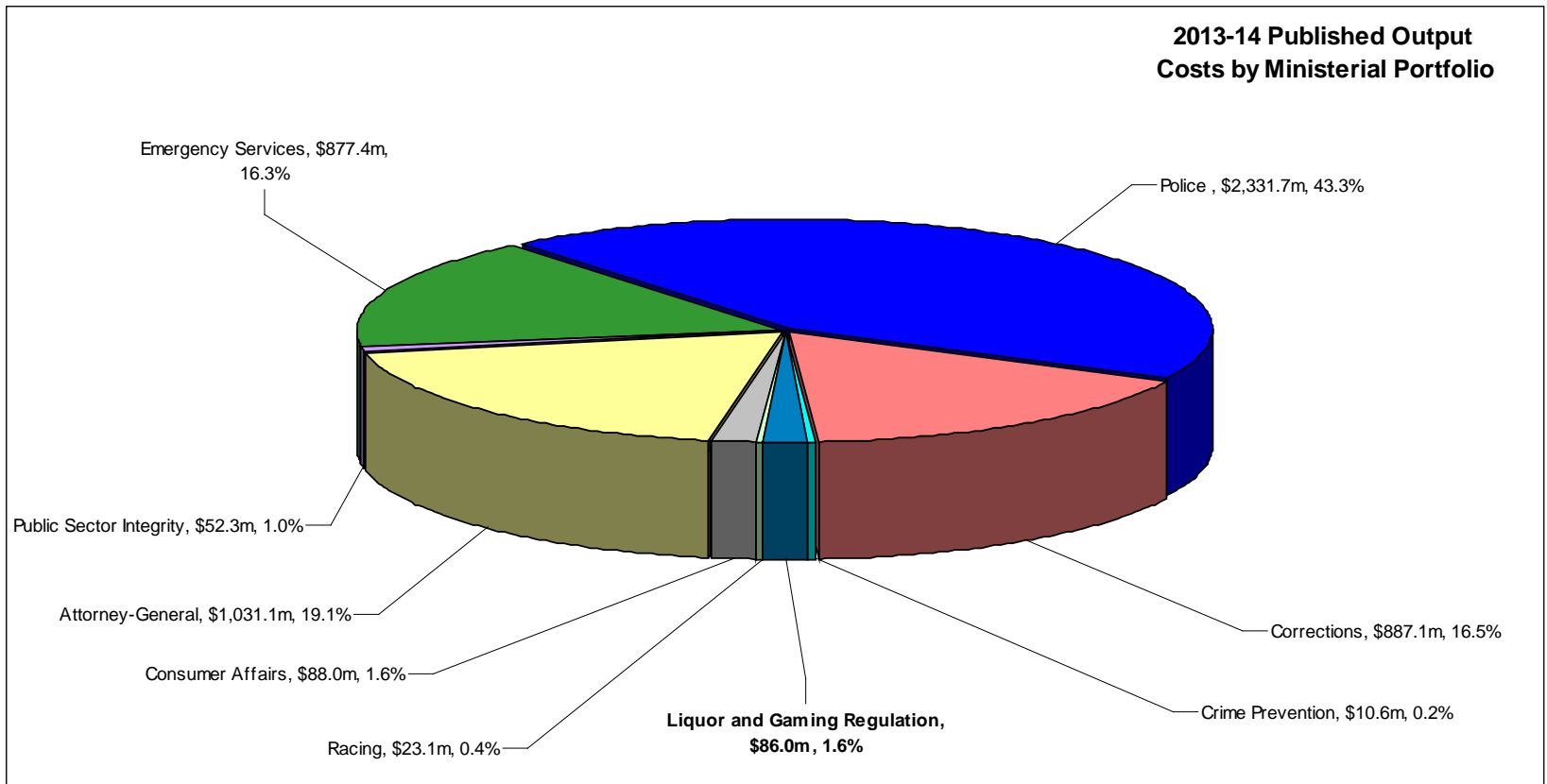

2012-13 Justice Budget Breakdown by Portfolio

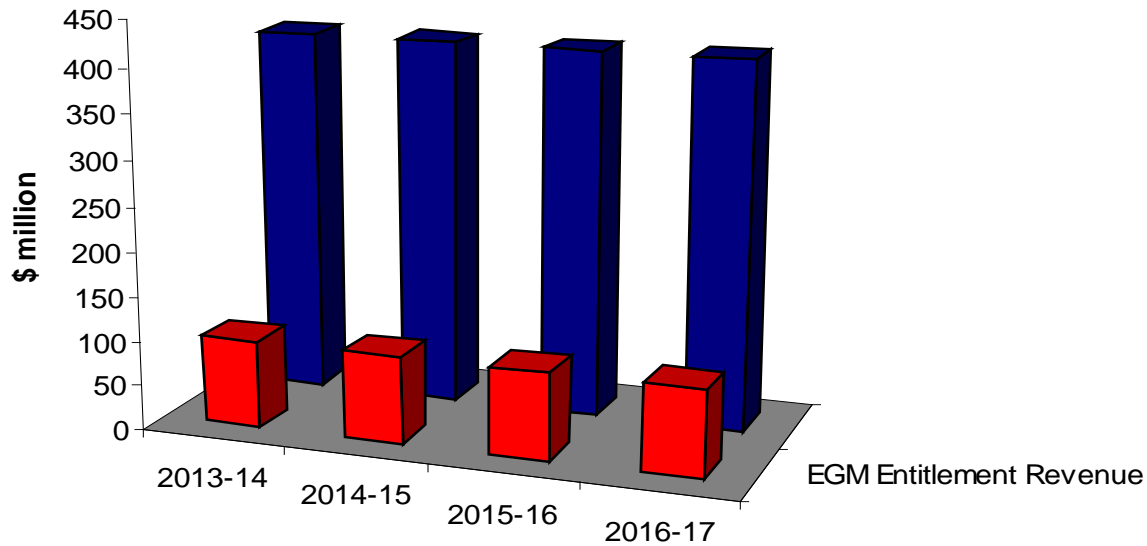


- Liquor and gaming: \$86 million

■ EGM Entitlement Revenue

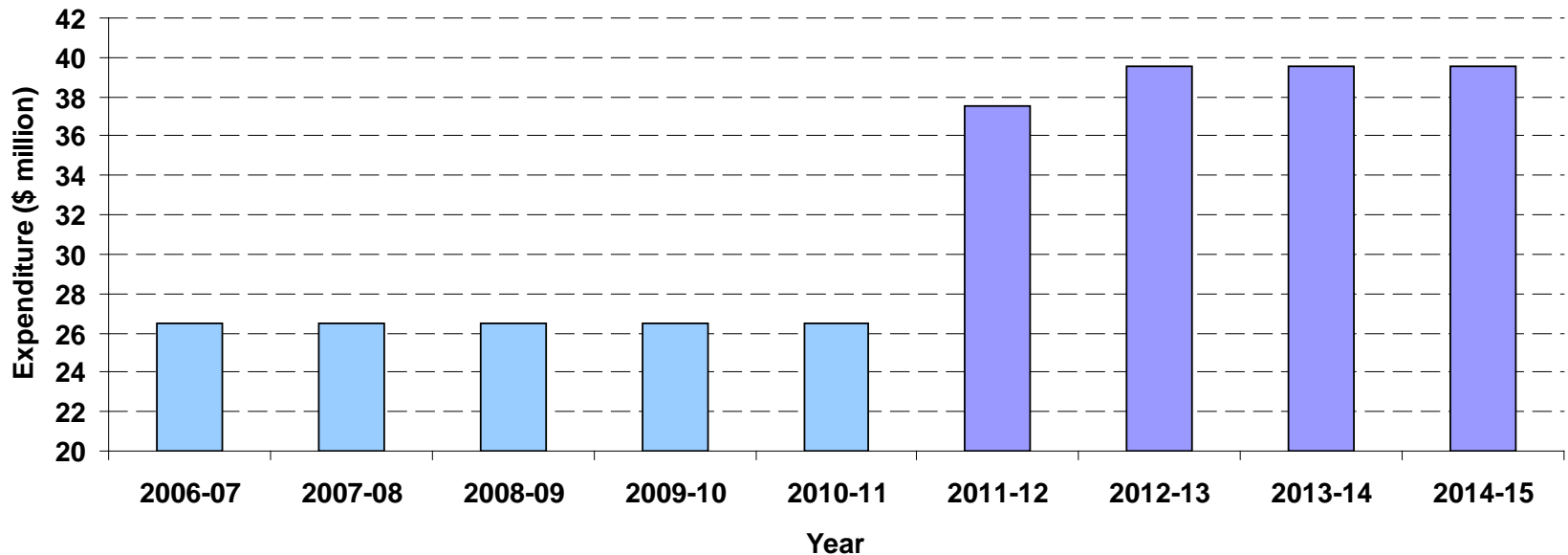
■ EGM Entitlement Revenue estimated by Auditor-General
