




## **Victorian Manufacturing Output**

# A More Competitive Manufacturing Industry

- The strategy sets out five priorities:
  - A world-class specialist manufacturing service
  - Productivity and innovation networks
  - Investing in technology
  - Support for small manufacturers
  - Niche and specialist skills

#### **VIPP Reforms:**

- Release of new VIPP Guidelines on 1 January 2013
- Better targeting
- Stronger monitoring and reporting conditions





## **Manufacturing Strategy**

- Investing in Manufacturing Technology: Grants totalling \$6.6 million so far provided to 40 businesses
- Manufacturing Productivity Networks: Grants totalling \$1.7 million so far provided to 11 networks comprising around 500 businesses
- Specialist Manufacturing Service: Improving firm's ability to access services and know-how required to improve business productivity to commence in June.
- Building Innovative and Small Manufacturers: Supporting innovative and small manufacturers to access the skills and capabilities that will help them become globally competitive – to commence in June.
