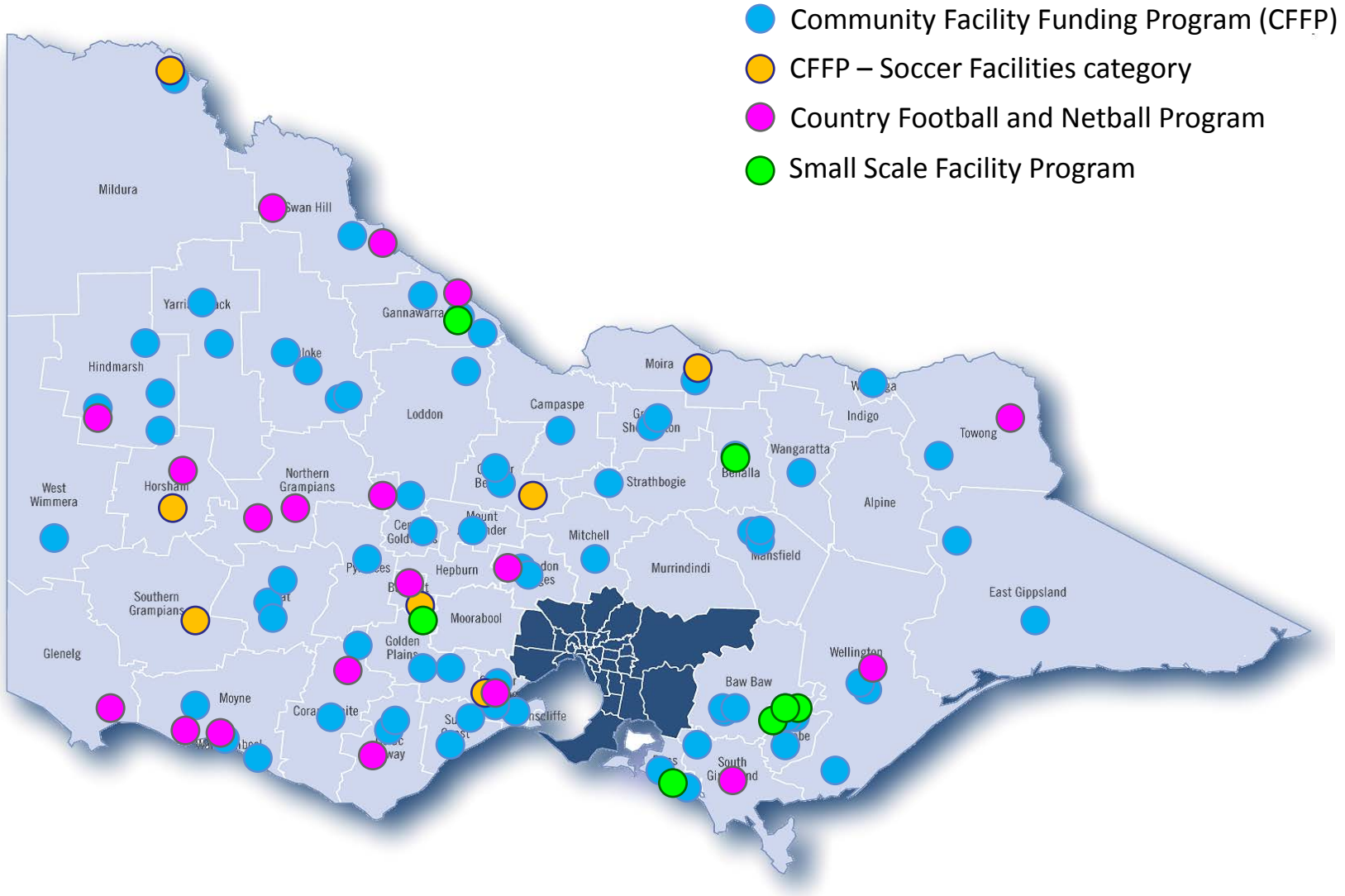

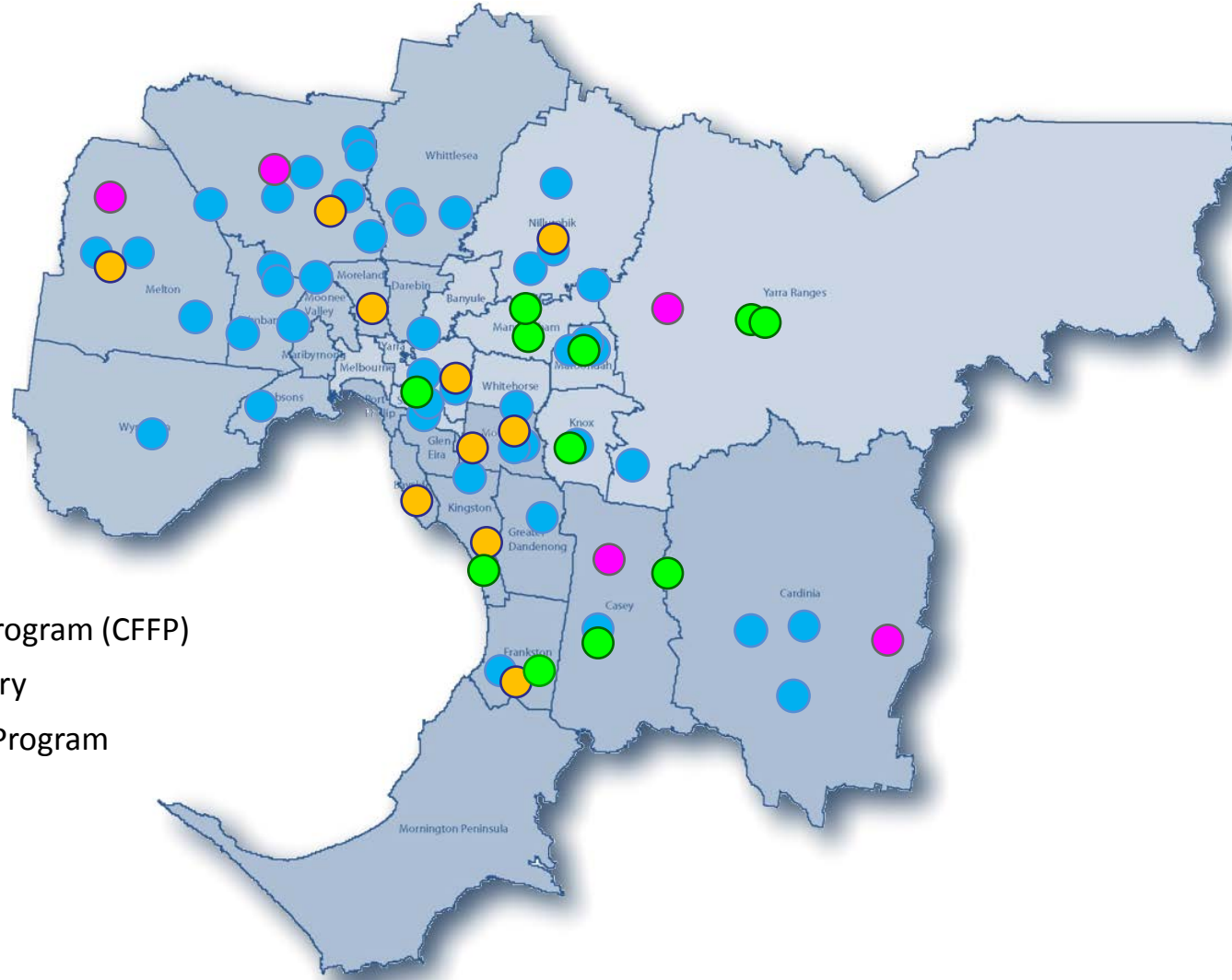

Community Facility Grants Metro Melbourne 2012-13



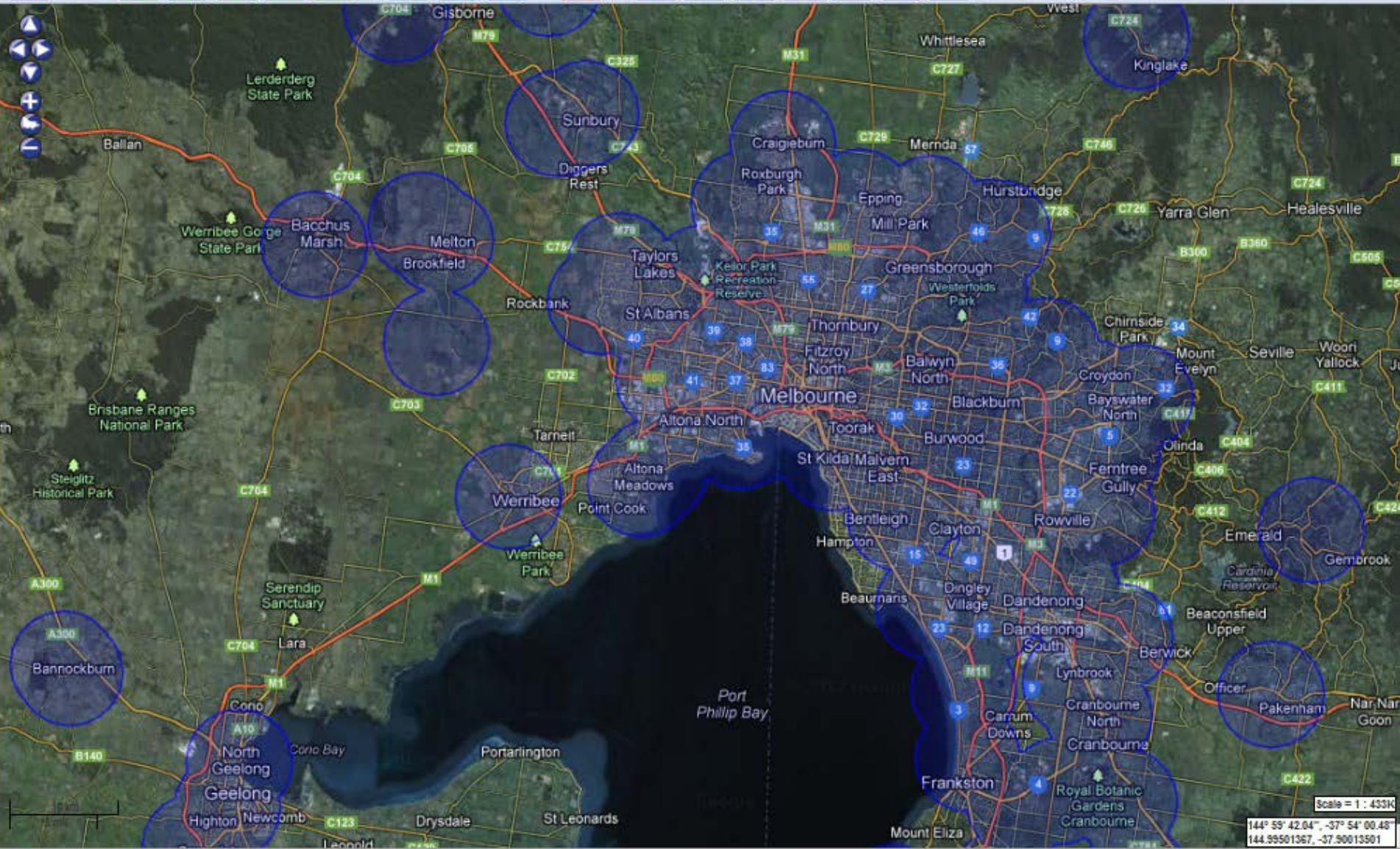
